"Investigating heterogeneity in alternatives, decision rules, contextual variables and choice set in commute mode choice"

The talk deals with differences in mode choice behavior due to heterogeneity in multiple components of decision-making – differences among IPT alternatives, heterogeneity in decision rule adopted by decision makers, heterogeneity in degree and source of captivity to personal vehicle, heterogeneity in the number of co-passengers during commute, heterogeneity in the treatment of the alternatives in the choice set etc.
